Christopher W. Coyea, Tenor, received his Bachelor of Music Degree from Wilfrid Laurier University, and did post-graduate work in Opera Performance. established Chris has international artistic reputation as a performer in Opera and in concert and was an award winner in prestigious Lauritz Melchior Heldentenor Competition in New York City. As a member of the Canadian Opera Company Ensemble, he has numerous productions: Salome, appeared in Tristan und Isolde, Queen of Spades, Carmen, Wozzeck and The Tales of Hoffmann. After leaving the Ensemble, he performed with the Toronto,



Winnipeg, Victoria and Kitchener-Waterloo Symphony Orchestras, as well as Orchestra London and the Hamilton Philharmonic. He has sung in the company of such singers as Dame Joan Sutherland, Placido Domingo, Carol Vaness, Dolores Ziegler, Ben Hepner and Richard Margison, just to name a few. Chris was also featured in a nation wide German tour of *Carmen* in 2003. Recent North American appearances include *The Taming of the Shrew* with Pacific Opera Victoria and Tenor Soloist in *A Salute to Vienna* in Montreal, Hamilton, Melbourne and St. Petersburg. Mr. Coyea has musically directed many shows at St. Lawrence College most recently including *Les Misérables*, *Anything Goes* and *The Mikado*.
